



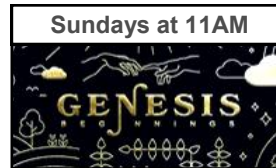

Be Like Annie - Pray - Give - Go

Annie Armstrong (1850-1938) was a trailblazing Southern Baptist leader and tireless missions advocate who revolutionized missionary fundraising and mobilization. She was the first corresponding secretary for the Woman's Missionary Union (WMU), and championed many women in ministry while organizing efforts that raised millions for North American and global missions. In 1934, the *Annie Armstrong Easter Offering for Home Missions* was unanimously renamed in her honor. Key aspects of her legacy:

- ⇒ Annie Armstrong was known as a "dreamer in action," revolutionizing mission support and championing women in ministry.
- ⇒ Annie organized Southern Baptist women to pray, give, and go.
- ⇒ Beginning in 1888 with 32 delegates representing 12 states, Annie was instrumental in building up the WMU into a network that today has grown to a million women across 20,000 churches.
- ⇒ For 18 years, Annie served as the Corresponding Secretary of the WMU without pay, and paid her own travel expenses until 1900.
- ⇒ Annie wrote tens of thousands of letters by hand to promote mission work.
- ⇒ Annie was a close friend to Lottie Moon and supported her efforts in China, organizing the annual *Christmas Offering for Missions*, later renamed in Lottie Moon's honor.
- ⇒ In 1934, the Home Mission Board renamed their annual Easter offering in honor of Annie Armstrong, which to date has raised over 2 billion dollars for North American missions.

You may give to the *Annie Armstrong Easter Offering for North American Missions (AAEO)* at CRBC throughout the month of April. Annie will always be remembered as a "tall, stately, out-spoken, strong-willed leader" who embodied passionate Christian service. May we all remember Annie Armstrong and her profound faith as we strive to dedicate our service of faithfulness to our Lord & Savior, Jesus Christ.
