This Sunday Is Palm Sunday at CRBC

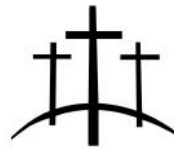

April - Food Roundup Month for the NC Baptist Children's Homes

The idea to establish an orphanage in North Carolina was brought up before the *NC Baptist State Convention* in 1884. It was rejected because of the cost and the existence of the *Oxford Masonic Orphanage*, which Baptists had helped organize.



However, supporters of this initiative appointed John Haymes Mills as the first general superintendent and commissioned him with the task of raising money and finding property to establish a home for children. A site was selected in Thomasville, and the first resident was admitted in 1885. Today, it is now one of the largest residential childcare facilities in the South, with services for residential group care, crisis emergency care, maternity services for unmarried women, elder care, and other care ministries.

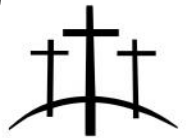
