Samaritan's Purse - Spreading the Gospel for Over a Half-Century

Samaritan's Purse was founded in 1970 by Baptist pastor Bob Pierce, the founder of World Vision International (Boone, NC). His mission was "to meet emergency needs in crisis areas through existing evangelical mission agencies and national churches." After visiting suffering children on the Korean island of Koje-do, Bob wrote the following, now famous words in his Bible: "Let my heart be broken with the things that break the heart of God." This impassioned prayer guided him forward.

In 1973, Bob met 22 year-old Franklin Graham, an adventurous young student who had a growing heart for world missions. In 1975, he accompanied Pierce on a tour of some of the world's most desperate mission fields. Franklin saw the poverty of paganism and the utter despair of the people it enslaved. This trip changed his life as God captured Franklin's heart for missions.

"Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him." Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise." — Luke 10:36-37

Following Pierce's death in 1978, Graham became President and Chairman of the Board, leading Samaritan's Purse by following the Biblical example of the Good Samaritan across the globe. God blessed the organization under Graham's leadership as this ministry has seen explosive growth. Today, Samaritan's Purse travels the world's highways looking for victims of war, poverty, natural disasters,

disease, and famine, sharing God's love through His Son, Jesus Christ. This is the mission of Samaritan's Purse: to follow the example of Christ by helping those in need and proclaiming the hope of the Gospel.
