Lessons from the Season of Easter

Easter is not a one-time event that happened centuries ago. It's a continuous, ongoing manifestation of the power of life over death, good over evil, and love over hatred. Our entire Christian faith is centered upon the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and we celebrated that this past Sunday. We enjoyed a delicious fellowship breakfast together followed by a worship service composed of meaningful, beautiful music and a *real* message of hope beyond the grave. What a wonderful opportunity to give glory, honor, and praise to our Father God for the empty tomb. But what are our next steps to be? What should we do with the excitement we have over the good news of Jesus' death and resurrection?

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit — Matthew 28:19

After Jesus died on the cross for the sins of mankind, the Bible tells us that the disciples were still processing what had happened and what the resurrection meant. Most of his disciples had abandoned Jesus in one way or another during his darkest hour as some fell asleep in the Garden of Gethsemane, some ran away when Jesus was taken prisoner, and Peter, among the closest of his disciples, denied even knowing Him three times that very night.

What should we do with the love, excitement, and joy that we have from Easter Sunday? Spring is known to be a time of new beginnings, second changes, and starting over. It's a good time to let go of our baggage, our guilt, and insecurities so that we can become a strong voice for Christ. Let's not hoard Christ. Let's get on with the business at hand: to spread the gospel to a dying world.

Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. — 1 Corinthians 15:58

Just like the disciples in the Bible, all disciples of Christ are commissioned to be disciples who make disciples. If we truly believe God's inspired word, let's share the good news that Jesus paid it all and all to Him we owe. Let's rejuvenate ourselves in the Lord and be inspired by the resurrection not just on Easter morning, but each and every morning. Because we are commission by Jesus Christ, and go with the power of the Holy Spirit, our labor will not be in vain; it has eternal meaning and value.
