On May 22, 2023, *Turner Cottage* in Hayesville, NC, was dedicated as a licensed foster home and part of Baptist Children's Homes (BCH). The home and property were purchased by a grant from the *Dogwood* Health Trust, but the property needed a lot of repairs. Those involved with this project had a dream for this home, but there was just not enough money to make it happen. This great need seemed impossible to meet, but they knew that with God, all things are possible and they began praying for a donor.

At the same time, C.B. Turner suffered a stroke and was hospitalized in Asheville. Already a financial donor, he had provided for BCH in his will. However, as he revisited his life and the many blessings God had given him, C.B. decided to do more by giving more. With a \$200,000 donation in hand, the renovations began and the rest is history. The *Turner Cottage* shows what God can do when one faithfully gives the glory to God.

Just who was C.B. Turner (the only wealthy Turner I had heard of was Ted)? C.B. grew up without indoor plumbing, became a Christian at the age of eleven and dedicated his life to serving the Lord. His focused on what God was calling him to do. He began his employment as an entry level technician at Burroughs Corporation, but climbed the ladder and eventually led the Burroughs Latin America and Caribbean region. When C.B. retired, he opened a chain of Arby's restaurants and once again, the rest is history. C.B. had become a multimillionaire while remaining focused on what God called him to do.

C.B. Turner peacefully passed away on Friday, June 30, 2023, at Maggie Valley Nursing & Rehabilitation Center after living a life of service and obedience while giving glory to God. As Christians, we know that it is by our actions that we are known. The way we live speaks eloquently of the One we serve.
