And, If you have participated in any of our outreach events, you have noticed Lydia and Gabe unloading cars and eagerly helping in any way they can. Thank you Lydia and Gabe! We also want to thank everyone who supported Reach Raleigh with their prayers, finances, time, and participation. A special thank you to Nina Pittari and *Schiano's Pizza* for providing the delicious pizza for our picnic. It truly "takes a village" to put together a successful event on this scale.

The children we served were appreciative, polite, and were looking forward to returning to school. The boys loved to talk about sports and were anxious to get back to practices and game night. Several volunteers had interactions with workers and residents: a maintenance worker, who moved here several years ago, told how only God could have taken away a 30-year addiction he had; a resident told how she has helped an Afghan family who lives beside her with English, carrying groceries, and just being kind. She hopes to visit CRBC in the near future.
