Who Was Lottie Moon?

Charlotte Digges "Lottie" Moon was born on December 12, 1840, in Albemarle County, Virginia. The Moons had money, a large family, servants, and a tutor in the home for the study of languages and classical literature. Despite her religious father, Lottie was not the least bit interested in religion as a child. She was a devilish little girl who only grew to be 4'3" tall. Even though her stature was small, Lottie was fearless and had a mind of her own. Attending church never suited Lottie, so she would skip Sunday services even though her father was a very involved deacon.
