The History Behind Lottie Moon and the Christmas Offering

Lottie Moon was born on December 12, 1840, to Edward and Anna Maria Moon. Raised in a large, wealthy family, Lottie grew up as a child of the old South. Her uncle had purchased the estate of Thomas Jefferson, and she grew up in a home built by a friend of George Washington. The Moons had eleven children, but only seven grew to adulthood. They had many servants and kept a tutor in the home for languages and classical literature.

The Moons were very religious people. Lottie's father was a founding member of Scottsville Baptist Church and a lifelong deacon. In order to preserve the Sabbath, the Moons would prepare their Sunday meals on Saturday. However, Lottie showed absolutely no interest in religion and frequently skipped church on Sundays. Her father passed away on a business trip when she was only thirteen, but even this unexpected and tragic loss did not change her attitude and disbelief in God.

At the age of fourteen, Lottie was enrolled in the Virginia Female Institute and proved to be a good student, especially in literature and foreign languages. It was apparent she benefited from those live-in tutors she had while growing up. She often skipped chapel and avoided any types of religious instruction. In next week's newsletter, you will read how God changed Lottie's life and how she became the missionary hero she is today.
