Community Caroling

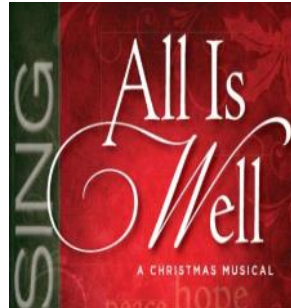

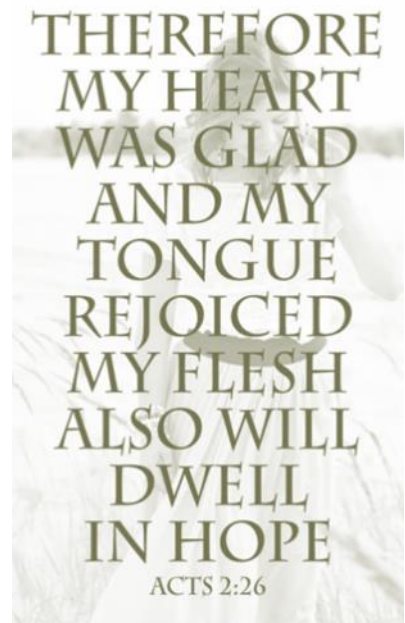
