According to *Wikipedia*, the phrase "random acts of kindness" first came from writer Anne Herbert. She scribbled those words down on a placemat in a restaurant in 1982. Anne came up with this phrase to counter the phrase "random acts of violence and senseless acts of cruelty," which was a go-to phrase of the late 1970s due to a rise in violent crime.

The Random Acts of Kindness Day first began in Denver, Colorado, in 1995 by a small nonprofit organization, *the Random Acts of Kindness Foundation*. This day is celebrated every year on February 17th with the idea of making this world a little brighter and better through simple, kind gestures, words, or actions at little to no cost. Examples:

- \Rightarrow Give an unexpected compliment.
- \Rightarrow Let someone go ahead of you in line.
- \Rightarrow Slow down so someone can merge in front of you in traffic.
- \Rightarrow Give someone your seat in a crowded place.
- \Rightarrow Listen with undivided attention.
- \Rightarrow Remembering to say *thank you*.
- \Rightarrow Volunteer and pay it forward.
- \Rightarrow Lend a hand to help your neighbor.
- \Rightarrow Offer help to those struggling with technology.
