Staying Alert by Watching, Working, and Walking

In a recent article in the *BGEA Decision Magazine*, our neighbor Anne Graham Lotz faithfully reminds us of the *Parable of the Faithful Servant* (*Matthew 24:42-51*). This story teaches us to stay faithful, doing the work of the Kingdom while awaiting the return of Christ.

In this parable, Jesus tells a story about a faithful servant who takes good care of his master's household while he is away. The faithful servant performs his duties at all times, whether the boss is looking or not. Jesus also shares an example of an unfaithful servant who mistreats others, becomes selfish, and drinks with the drunkards. This servant is not prepared for the return of his master, and will be judged severely when his master returns.

Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming... Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect — Matthew 24:42,44

Both then and today, Jesus challenged his disciples to stay alert and watch, because He will come at an hour we do not expect. We should stay alert by working to save lost souls, witnessing at all times. With our eyes wide open, Jesus wants us to stay alert by starting each day in service to Him with a constant state of readiness, giving eternal hope to the tired & weary.

Lastly, we are to stay alert by walking.....walking with God, and in the likeness of his son, to be obedient children; disciples making disciples. What will we be doing when Jesus returns to earth to gather his church, when the time for mercy will be over and the time to punish evil will begin?
