Reach Raleigh Begins This Sunday

Sunday, July 23rd: Churchwide Prayer Walk — Meet at the church at 4PM to pair off into teams to walk our neighborhood (Brookhaven and surrounding areas) to pray for our neighbors and our Reach Raleigh week. You will be given a prayer guide. If you are unable to walk, we will have a "prayer car" that will drive around the neighborhood as well. Please prepare your heart prior for Reach Raleig

the prayer walk by confessing your own sin and spending time in worship.

Monday, July 24th: Letters to Visitors and Final Mail out for Sports Clinic — Meet at the church at 1PM to write letters to visitors and those that we can encourage. We will also do a final mail out for our Sports

Tuesday, July 25th: Rest, Recovery & Prayer — There is no designated event this day. Use this day to intentionally pray for/serve others, and also rest so that you will be ready to for the events to come.

Wednesday, July 26th: Random Acts of Kindness for a Neighbor — This is the day you

RANDOM ACTS get to put your faith into action and follow through with your prayers from the previous days. Please reach out and serve at least one neighbor on this day. This can be done in a variety of different KINDNESS

ways, so get creative, but also be intentional as this is specifically meant for you to engage a LOST neighbor/friend, meaning someone that does not know Jesus or attend church (NOT a fellow church member). You can cut their grass, prepare food or order them take out, leave a nice basket of summer toys (like bubble soap and water squirters) on their front porch (if they have children), etc. You can also leave a kind note to them in the basket or on their doorstep after you serve them in some capacity. Let the Holy Spirit guide you with this because He knows their needs better than you do. Be intentional!

Thursday, July 27th: Rest, Recovery & Prayer — (See Tuesday).

Friday, July 28th: Church Work Day — At 9AM, come meet the Alabama mission team and work around the church to help beautify our facility and prepare it for our Sports Clinic on Saturday. If you have wheelbarrows, garden rakes, shovels, trimmers, chainsaws, loppers, or any other garden/yard tools that would be of use, then please bring them. The time will be announced soon.





Saturday, July 29th: Sports Clinic — On this day we will offer a Sports Clinic for ages 6-12 from 9AM to 12PM. Be there by 8:30AM to set up and make sure we are ready for our campers. The Alabama mission team will be helping us put on this clinic, but we still need your help with snacks, registration, and other needs for our sports clinic.

Sunday, July 30th: Covered Dish Luncheon — Our mission team will worship with us as Pastor Kevin Johnson will bring the message at 11AM. Immediately following the service, bring something delicious as we will share a Covered Dish Luncheon with the mission team before they head back to Alabama.


