A heartfelt "thank you" to Pastor Danny & Courtnie for reaching out to Daniel Ritchie to speak at CRBC this past Sunday. What a blessing it was for Daniel to give his testimony, sharing his love for and showing his obedience to, his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

While studying the Gospel Project lesson (*1 Samuel 11*) for this coming Sunday, there was a commentary that not only applies to our lesson, but also serves as encouragement for us today. Here is just a snippet of what the writer said when referring to Saul:

God took an unqualified man from a twisted town with a wicked history and, by the power of the Spirit, raised him up to lead Israel to save the people of Jabesh-Gilead. It's important to remember that no matter the heritage or history of a person, God still sits on the throne over the universe, and He can use whomever He chooses to accomplish His purposes.

Those words caused me to immediately think about Daniel Ritchie and his story. God saved Daniel at birth in order for His plan and purpose for Daniel to be fulfilled. When a youth pastor opened God's word to him, Daniel came to know the Lord, turned his life over to Him, and now lives a life of service to Him.

You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him. — Deuteronomy 13:4

The takeaway from hearing Daniel's story is that God can and will use us just the way we are: *fearfully and wonderfully made (Psalm 139:13-14)*. God does not require our arms, hands, or feet for us to accomplish His will, but He does require a contrite heart that walks in faith and lives in obedience. Like Daniel Ritchie, God created us, blessed us, and has equipped us for His glory and our good. Please continue to pray for Daniel's ministry and for hearts to be changed. May we use our time, gifts, and talents to show and share our faith as faithful, obedient children that make a difference in our world today.
