BEGA Crusade Updates

In recent months, the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association (BGEA) reported fruitful trips to Vietnam and to the Tidewater region of Maryland, Virginia, and North Carolina: Read the articles below to see how God uses disciples to make disciples.

Historic Gospel Ministry In Vietnam: When the team arrived in the capital city of Hanoi, they were graciously welcomed by the Deputy Prime Minister.

His delegation expressed their appreciation for the churches who helped their communities during the pandemic. The day before the Spring Love Festival was to begin in Ho Chi Minh City, the People's Committee hosted a special luncheon for the BGEA team, members of the U.S. Consulate, and for many of the Vietnamese pastors and church leaders who made this gospel outreach possible.

God provided the beautiful weather for both nights of the crusade as Michael W. Smith led the worshipful music. Tens of thousands heard the clear message of the good news that "the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world." Thousands came forward to the invitation to repent of their sins and receive Jesus Christ as Lord of their lives. Copies of the Gospel of John were given to all who attended, and each person who made a decision for Jesus Christ received a New Testament along with the BGEA discipleship booklet.

Please pray for those who made this life-changing decision for Jesus Christ, asking the Lord to draw them close to Him. May they become bold witnesses for the gospel.

God Loves You Tidewater Tour: From the Southern Potomac of Maryland to the Albemarle Sound in Edenton, NC, the Tidewater Tour recently reached out to six

regions with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Unseasonably cold temperatures and pouring rain didn't prevent thousands of people from hearing God's word, and many responded in repentance & faith.

The tour ended in Edenton, NC, a town of less than 5,000, with 7,500 people from across the region in attendance. They heard the gospel message, and hundreds eagerly embraced salvation in Jesus Christ. Bibles and discipleship resources were passed out. Cathie, who had just made a commitment to follow Jesus, received special words from one of the prayer volunteers, "Happy Birthday, you now have a spiritual birthday!"

Please pray for BGEA and the work they continue to do to build up His Kingdom; for these new believers and the local men and women who will continue to minister to them.
