## Let the Summer Special Olympic Games Begin

If you have supported the *Baptist Children's Homes* with your prayers, finances, or donations of food/supplies, you now have a connection with the two men that will compete this summer in the *2022 Special Olympic US Games* in Orlando. Rob & Alex are "best buds" and are residents at the *Alverta Bolick BCH* in Asheville. This duo are also teammates on the *Buncombe County Special Olympic Soccer Team*. In fact, all five of the Bolick Home residents participate at County Special Olympics. Rob is a "Global Messenger" trained in public speaking, and serves as an ambassador for the *Special Olympics*. He also recruits potential athletes, volunteers, and sponsors through public presentations. Both men enjoy playing soccer and know how to pass the ball, the position they play, and what is expected in the game. They are very excited about flying to Orlando in a private jet.

Most everyone has a story about their life; Rob and Alex are no different. Rob, at 36, was the first resident to live at the Bolick Home after it opened in 2006. Now 52, Rob admits it was hard to leave his childhood home in nearby Weaverville, but he frequently returns to visit his mother. He is more somber when he reflects about his Dad's passing in 2019. However, Rob loves living in the Bolick home with the other men: they play games and just have a good time together. His housemates have become his favorite people.

At 18 years old, Alex came to the Bolick Home in 2009 shortly after his mother died of cancer. Now 30, Alex lets everyone know that Rob is his very special friend, and each Sunday, they walk together to *Calvary Baptist Church* (the same church was attended by *Alverta Bolick*, the home's benefactor) for Bible study and worship. Alex thinks God is great, and looks forward to going to heaven and meeting Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The men stay busy during the week by attending community college classes and participating in other off-site activities.

We thank God for His providential care in providing this ministry to serve adults with special intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). The Bolick Home is one of nine homes in six communities in NC that fosters a Christian atmosphere with opportunities for spiritual enrichment and enhancement of daily independent living and social skills.
