Satan Is Desperate


In the May issue of the *BGEA Decision Magazine*, there was an interesting article from a sermon Billy Graham preached in 1972. He thought crime was on the rampage, extremist groups threatened to use terrorist tactics; drug addicts were committing more and more crimes in order to get more and more drugs; people were afraid to walk the streets not only at night, but in the daytime as well; pornography, crime, filth, materialism, and the decline the institutional church and Biblical faith were prevalent. People everywhere were wondering what had happened, what could they do about it, and where could they turn.

***Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil—
Ephesians 6:11***

Billy Graham went on to say, "No Christian anywhere in the world is exempt from this great spiritual conflict. God has no place for spiritual pacifists. The Bible indicates that our enemies are powerful and desperate. The Scriptures describe Satan as the bitterest enemy of God, and he is a cruel adversary."

Some fifty-two years later, this dilemma still goes on. The article ended with this advice for us today: "Americans believe that Washington should solve everything. We've come to believe that money and education is the answer to everything. Our great problem is a spiritual problem, and until we have a spiritual and moral renewal, we will go from crisis to crisis. The greatest contribution you can make as an individual is to live a clean, honest, humble, Spirit-filled life, to trust God to guard and protect you morally, to become a part of that vocal minority that is openly and publicly witnessing for the Lord Jesus Christ, and to identify yourself as a true believer in your community. Let us be servants of God during this hour."
