Will graduated from Liberty University in 1997 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Religion, and in 2001, graduated from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity degree. Since beginning his evangelistic

ministry in 2006, Will has shared the hope of Jesus Christ with more than 1 million

people across six continents. He will be quick to tell you, "I am not trying to be the next Billy Graham; I have a burden in my heart to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. If that's to an arena full of people or one person on the street. I will do whatever God is calling me to do."

Kentucky Mission Trip: This Sunday Is the Deadline to Sign Up

CRBC has partnered with *Baptists on Miss*ion to serve others in one of the most impoverished regions in the USA. We depart Sunday afternoon, May 18th and return Friday, May 23rd. We will drive to Stearns, Kentucky, to assist *Crossroads Community*



Church with their ministry, The Lord's Café, that provides free meals in a restaurant setting. We will help serve lunch, help with a dinner buffet, and a food pantry giveaway. In addition, we have the opportunity to help with their tiny home ministry, The Light Community, that provides free housing for the homeless, those in recovery, and young adults transitioning out of foster care. There are various costs (est. \$250-\$300) to participate in this ministry that includes lodging, meals, and an optional visit to the Ark Encounter (\$65 + lodging).

There are at least 3 ways for you to participate in this mission trip:

- ⇒ **The best way... GO:** In you can **GO**, contact Pastor Danny as soon as possible. Several more volunteers are still needed to make this trip a reality. <u>Sign up ends this Sunday, March 16th.</u>
- ⇒ **GIVE:** If you cannot afford the <u>time</u> to go, you can help sponsor someone cannot afford the <u>cost</u> to go; **GIVE** any amount you can to help send someone in your place. 
