Where Is Our Hope?

Some of you may have been following the news from Tucson, Arizona concerning the sudden disappearance, in the dark of night, of 84 year-old Nancy Guthrie, mother of the *Today Show* anchor, Savannah Guthrie. Nancy's family has been pleading with whoever removed her from her home to please, return their mother to them. More than 26 days have passed since her disappearance with no real leads. The family has recently offered up to a million dollars for information leading to Nancy's return.

Even with so few leads, the Guthrie family still has hope. They have hope that someone will come forward with good, solid information about Nancy's whereabouts. They have hope for good results that will come from labs and other means of investigation. They have hope she could still be alive. Finally, they have hope she will be returned to her family. They just want her home!

Whenever Savannah has spoken publicly, there is something resonating and uplifting in her words. She speaks about her faith in God and her hope for someone to come forward with information. She has hope in the continued prayers of many people praying for Nancy to be returned to her family. It is evident that Savannah's faith and hope is still in her Lord. She realizes that her mother may have already gone home to be with our Lord, and recently said, "what is to be, we will accept." It has been encouraging to hear Savannah's words of hope.

Rejoice in your hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer — Romans 12:12

Where is our hope? The Bible says that hope is not a mere wish, but a confident, joyful expectation based on God's faithfulness, promises, and power. Hope acts as a secure anchor for the soul providing strength during suffering and trust in God's plan rather than our current circumstances. He is our solid rock!

While we may never know the answers to the many questions concerning the Guthrie family's ordeal, we have seen and heard much evidence of the love, faith, trust, and hope they have in our Heavenly Father. We have a good, good God who loves his children and knows what is best for each of them. He has a plan and a purpose for the Guthrie family and for ours, too. May our hope always be in God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
