Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey — Zechariah 9:9

Jesus came not only as Israel's King, but also as her Savior, granting eternal salvation through spiritual means rather than by political force. As He entered the city, onlookers laid their garments down in front of Him and waved palm branches: a sign of honor, praise, and respect while they proclaimed, "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" Some in the crowd did not know who Jesus was and were told, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee."

Jesus entered the city knowing He would be tried and crucified, but invited his fate in order to be raised from the grave and save us from our sins. *Palm Sunday* marks the beginning of *Holy Week*, the remembrance of his steps toward the cross. As Christians, we believe his Holy Word reveals great truth in every part of this story. When we worship together this Palm Sunday, may our thoughts and attention be directed towards Jesus Christ and may we draw closer to Him. We invite you to invite others to join us as we worship our one, true God, and give Him all glory, honor, and praise.
