

So, then, be careful how you live. Do not be unwise but wise, making the best use of your time because the times are evil. Therefore, do not be foolish but understand what the Lord's will is — Ephesians 5:15-17

As Christians, we are not to manage our time the same way the world manages theirs: we are to seek God in everything we do. In a 2014 Blog, Billy Graham had this to stay about using our time more wisely:

Billy Graham - 4 Steps to Use Your Time More Wisely

- First, see each day as a gift from God thank God each day when we awake for the gift of another day.
- Second, commit your time to God we are accountable to God for the way we use our time.
- Third, set aside time for God and for others; put Him at the top of our "To Do List."
- Fourth, take time for your own needs as we all need rest & recreation. Jesus told His disciples, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest" Mark 6:31.

Pray for us all to become better stewards of this precious gift of time, to gain more control over how we spend our time, and to use it for His glory and our good.
