



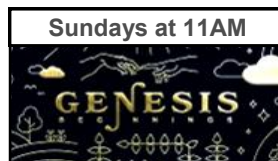

Two Eternal Things - God's Word & Man's Soul

A recent article from the ever enlightening *Billy Graham Evangelistic Association's Decision* magazine highlighted the meager beginnings of David Green, founder and CEO of *Hobby Lobby*, which operates more than 1,000 arts & crafts stores in 48 states. David's father was a Pentecostal pastor who never pastored a church of more than 100 people and his mother was a devout evangelist.

David would often hear the humble and honest pleas to God from his dad for provisions and blessings during the middle of the night. Their prayer life left him with an indelible memory of how God provided for his mom, dad, and their six children.

One of David's first jobs was picking cotton, where he quickly learned about hard work. His next job was at a local five-and-dime, where he caught the “retail bug” and never looked back. In 1972, the first *Hobby Lobby* opened in a 600 square-foot storefront in Oklahoma City. Fifty years later, that one store has grown into a thousand, with annual sales exceeding eight billion dollars.

The earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein — Psalm 24:1

Like many others, the road to success hasn't been without bumps. In 1985, the regional economy tanked across the Southern plain. Twelve of their stores saw profits fall by a million dollars in a single year. It was a sobering time, a time that God humbled David and reminded him about God's ownership of everything.

David Green has learned that we all have time, talent, and whatever else God has given us... and we need to use them. For over 20 years, the Green family has given 50% of their company profits to not merely Christian-oriented; but gospel-focused causes. Because of their success, the family has invested more than a billion dollars in Christian work globally through the *Hobby Lobby Foundation*, and other related non-profits and ministry partners. Together, they have translated God's Word, in written and/or audio form, into over 6,000 languages and dialects. And in 2017, the family opened the 430,000 square-foot *Museum of the Bible* near the National Mall in Washington, DC for all to see.

David says, “That's what we are here for and that's what we do. People wonder why we keep opening new stores. Well, so we can do more of this, that's why. To tell people about Jesus. It's about God's Word and man's soul. We want to commit ourselves to those two things.” Amen.
