Keep on Keeping on in the Faith

Most of us have heard the words, "our world is broken." First of all, let's remember that God created a perfect world for his creation to live in and enjoy. Therefore, it's not the world that is broken but the people who live in it. Not long after creation, Adam sinned, revealing sin's ugly face to humanity. In May 2024, sin is still running rampant, so we must move with urgency to do our part to share the life saving gospel to the broken people around us.

You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You — Isaiah 26:3

In wondering how to respond to this brokenness, the Bible gives us the answers. The inspired Word of God is the perfect place to keep our hearts

focused and our minds at peace in times of trouble; to stabilize us in unstable times. The Bible also gives us the certain hope that our ultimate future rests in God's capable and loving hands. It is the assurance that the invisible God is faithful and has a good plan for our visible lives. We can trust Him completely, no matter what happens on this side of heaven. The following reminders may assist you as you lean on his promises:

- Protect your peace remember the words of Jesus, the Prince of Peace (John 14:27)
- Guard your thoughts change what you are thinking about (*Philippians 4:8*)
- Talk to God about it; pray continually (1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- Stay busy minding your own business (2 Thessalonians 3:11)
- Seek opportunities to do good (Galatians 6:10)
- Be light in the darkness (Isaiah 58:10)
- Remember, times like these have been prophesied (2 Timothy 3:1-4)
- Know that God is in control (Psalm 22:28)
- Expect God to calm the raging storm (Mark 4:39)
- You don't have to fight your own battles (Proverbs 21:31)

Trouble, hate, and violence seem to be everywhere, but so is our omnipresent God. When everything seems to be falling apart, God will hold your mind and life together. Just trust Him and his wonder, working power.
