



On May 13, 1864, Private William Christman became the first soldier to be buried at Arlington National Cemetery. On June 15, 1864, the army formally designated 200 acres of the property as a military cemetery. Today, there are over 400,000 graves of men & women (and eligible dependents) who sacrificed in service to our country. Every American owes a tribute to these often
