A Purse with a Purpose Reminder

During the last meeting (February 17, 2020) of the Margaret Wheeler Missionary Circle, Sandy Choate told us of a project that was very successful in a friend's church in another state. The project was very simple; look in your closet for that gently used purse that you could donate and fill it with different things a woman could use. We quickly decided this would be something fun and exciting to do and more importantly, it would show women in our area that we love and care about them. Information about our project was placed in the newsletter/bulletin and a purse was put on display in the Welcome Center with a list of suggested items to place in the bag as an example.

At that time, we knew about COVID-19, but had no idea of the high number of deaths it would bring and the negative impact it would have on our city, state and indeed the world! We have reached out to the *Salvation Army*, *Dress For Success*, *RBA*, and *Healing Transitions* regarding which non-profits could use our bags and would give to women who could benefit from our donation. Unfortunately, most organizations do not yet know when they will be open for classes and offer other helpful activities for women. Considering the economy, we believe this is a great time give these bags, so we are moving ahead with our project. If you are able to donate a bag for this project, please bring your bag to the Welcome Center no later than Sunday, June 28th.
