The Power, Purpose, and Value of Prayer

Do you ever wonder why we need to pray? If God is all powerful, all knowing, and already has a plan & purpose for us, why should we pray? The answer is simple: God wants us to pray primarily in order to build an intimate relationship with Him, not because He needs information, but because it aligns our hearts with his, shapes our character, and invites his presence and power into our lives.

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you — 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

When we pray, we have a direct line of communication to connect with God. We share our hearts with Him like we would with our dearest, best friend and that is just who He is. He is our creator, redeemer, promise keeper, Savior, and sanctifier. He is someone who knows us better than we know ourselves. The following statements are key reasons why God wants us to pray:

- ⇒ Prayer is a direct line of communication, allowing us to connect with God and experience closeness with Him.
- ⇒ Prayer transforms us internally, helping us to align our desires and plans with God's greater, purposeful plan for our lives.
- ⇒ Prayer is an act of humility that reminds us we are not in control and that we do depend on God for our needs.
- ⇒ Prayer is a time we take our worries and our needs to God that brings peace, comfort, and strength to overcome stress and temptation.
- ⇒ Prayer is a persistent, sincere two-way conversation with God, focusing on gratitude, faith, and aligning with his will.
- ⇒ Prayer is intercessory as we pray on behalf of others, including family, friends, leaders, and our world.
- ⇒ Prayer is asking God for forgiveness as taught in the Lord's Prayer.
- ⇒ Prayer is commanded by God and demonstrates our obedience and service to God.

In essence, prayer is not for God's benefit, but our own, allowing us to grow spiritually, receive his grace, and participate in his work. May we never suffer from missed opportunities when we neglect to earnestly pray to our Father God.
