Be Doers of the Word, Not Hearers Only

In a recent study of church attendance, trends show a disturbing shift away from weekly attendance as a growing number of Americans identify themselves as religiously unaffiliated. The Gallup study found that 30% of Americans attend religious services nearly every week, which is a decrease of 42% from the early 2000s. Also troubling, younger generations are seemingly shifting away from traditional religious views.

The pandemic may have exacerbated these trends, but studies reveal that those with weaker commitments to regular church attendance have stopped attending at a higher rate. And while online services are gaining in popularity, most church-going Americans still prefer to attend in person. That said, nearly all faiths are seeing declines in their regular worship attendance.

But these are the ones sown on good ground, those who hear the word, accept it, and bear fruit: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some a hundred — Mark 4:20

While there are no “studies” to reveal the heart of every community, we all know a neighbor, coworker, or close friend who needs Jesus in their lives. Let's remember, the church serves as God's hands, mouth, and feet in this world. We should do the things that Jesus Christ did when He was here on earth. The church is to be both “Christ-like” and Christ following, especially in times like these. In a recent devotional, Rick Warren had this to say:

Maybe you think you're waiting on God. You think you're waiting on God for that job. You think you're waiting on God for a spouse. You think you're waiting on God for the windfall. God says, "you think you're waiting on me? I'm waiting on you to plant a seed."

We are not to wait for God to do everything for us. We are a big part of the mission of the Great Commission to go and tell. Let's invite someone to church so they can hear that we've all messed up and that God's grace is for everyone.

For the Christian, there is never nothing to do - there is always prayer. Pray this week that God will encourage each of us to live a life of loving God and living Jesus. Plant and nurture seeds of faith at every opportunity, trusting God to bring the growth and harvest.
