As a nation, we will celebrate *Veterans Day* this Saturday, November 11th, but do you know why it's on this date? In 1918, World War I ended at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month. The first observance of this historic moment, known as *Armistice Day*, was the following year on November 11, 1919. On June 1,1954, Congress amended legislation to change the name and scope of the holiday to *Veterans Day*, as a day to honor all military veterans of the *United States Armed Forces*, both living and dead, for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good.

We salute the men and women who have served our country in the past and those who keep us safe today. Thank you for your service and the many sacrifices you have made in order to protect our land, our American way of life, and our democracy.
