Happy Birthday CRBC - Celebrating 217 Years, October 7, 1807-2024

As we celebrate this milestone in the life of our church, please enjoy reading a little about the trajectory of CRBC throughout these years .

- ⇒ *Mount Zion Baptist Church* was constituted on October 7, 1807 in Holly Springs, NC.
- ⇒ In 1886, after moving to several meeting places over time, the members settled into a building on Ridge Path Road, known today as Jeffrey's Grove School Rd.
- ⇒ The building was used for preaching every 1st & 3rd Sundays and as a training station for ministerial students.
- ⇒ Over time, both membership and attendance shrank and the church needed financial help.
- ⇒ In 1942, due to rubber tires being rationed during WWII, the church voted to discontinue nightly meetings and hold Sunday School, Prayer Meetings, and Training Union all on Sunday mornings.
- ⇒ In 1950, members Leroy & Lessie Goodwin generously donated the land for a well planned, modern structure to be built facing Hwy 15 A (today known as Creedmoor Rd.), at a cost of \$25,000.
- ⇒ In December of 1952, Mrs. Ella Kelly donated two lots just down from CRBC to build a church parsonage. In 1980, that parsonage went up for sale for an asking price of \$50,000.
- ⇒ In 1958, a new block building was built on the back lot of the church property at a cost of \$9,500.
- ⇒ On August 3, 1965, a deed was executed that conveyed all properties under the name *Mount Zion Baptist Church* to *Creedmoor Road Baptist Church*.
