#### We Plant, We Water, and We Leave the Rest to God

In 1973, 24 year-old Anthony Tyrone "Tony" Evans was a junior at *Dallas Theological Seminary*. He was asked to provide some preaching content for a local radio program. He willingly agreed and spent the next few years preaching into a microphone to an unseen crowd. In 1976, Tony and his wife started a Bible Study in their home with only ten people. Not long after, they founded the *Oak Cliff Bible Fellowship* church.

Over the next forty-plus years, the church building was built, the now Dr. Evans became a well-known pastor and speaker, an author of over 100

books, booklets and Bible studies, and a syndicated radio and television broadcaster. He holds the honor of writing and publishing the first full-Bible commentary & study Bible by an African American. Today, his broadcasts are heard on 1,400 radio outlets in over 130 countries, reaching millions each week. He has served as chaplain for both the *NFL Dallas Cowboys* and the *NBA Dallas Mavericks*, and remains as the senior pastor of *Oak Cliff Bible Fellowship* church, now with an astounding 9,500 members.
