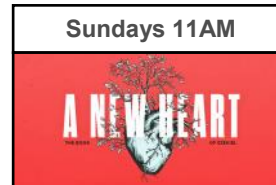

- To support the leading and work of the pastor in: sharing the gospel, assisting with gatherings, promoting and addressing unity, and providing a proper example to the church.

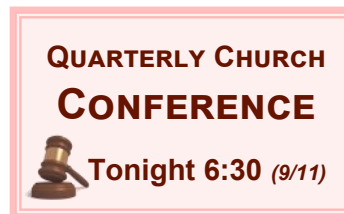
