The Bible - Our Playbook for Life

If you are an avid football fan, this recent article from the *Decision Magazine* will certainly attract your attention. There is also a good chance you are familiar with the names of NFL Hall of Fame Coach Tony Dungy and three time Emmy award-winning network television broadcaster, James Brown. Let's take a quick look at both of these godly men:

Seventy-two year-old James "JB" Brown is the host of *The NFL Today* on CBS and is a special correspondent for the network's news division. Inducted into the *Sports Broadcasting Hall of Fame* in 2021, Brown will host CBS Sports' coverage of *Super Bowl LVIII* in Allegiant Stadium on February 11, 2024 in Paradise, Nevada. JB is also an ordained minister, serving as an on-staff minister at his church. He strongly believes the God we serve is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

Sixty-seven year-old Tony Dungy played defensive back for the 1979 Super Bowl Champion Pittsburgh Steelers. In 2007, with the Indianapolis Colts, he became the first African American head coach to win a Super Bowl. Currently, Dungy is an NFL analyst and commentator for *NBC Sunday Night Football* as well as a #1 *New York Times* bestselling author whose books include *Quiet Strength*, *Uncommon*, *The*

Mentor Leader, and Uncommon Marriage. Some of Dungy's most profound words were said earlier this year when he said that he would not be silenced by the vitriolic criticism aimed at him for speaking at the annual March for Life rally in Washington D.C.

For the last 13 years, these two men, along with several dozen others, have committed to partner in a weekly Bible study that, due to their schedules, often require phone/video calls. In April, they co-anchored a men's retreat at *the Billy Graham Training Center at the Cove* in nearby Asheville, NC. More than 400 men attended and as a result, more than a dozen attendees gave their lives to Christ!

Both these men recognize that God has given them a platform on the media's biggest stage for His glory, not their own. May our heavenly Father continue to lead, guide, and direct men of faith, who use the Bible, God's inerrant, infallible word, as their playbook for life.
