Deacon Nominations

CRBC will soon be electing deacons to join Lee Elledge on the Diaconate. The duties of a deacon are as follows:

- . To serve the Lord's Supper.
- . To minister to assigned church member families, providing: prayer, friendship, emotional support, witnessing, guidance, visitation, and opportunities for fellowship and service, with special attention given to widowed, shut-in, hospitalized, or ill members.
- . To support the leading and work of the pastor in: sharing the gospel, assisting with gatherings, promoting and addressing unity, and providing a proper example to the church.

At CRBC, deacons are not leaders, but rather servants of the church. They must be men or women over the age of 21, active church members for one year or more, and in good standing. No two members of the same household may serve as deacons at the same time. The Biblical qualifications for deacons are found in [1 Timothy 3:8-13](#).
